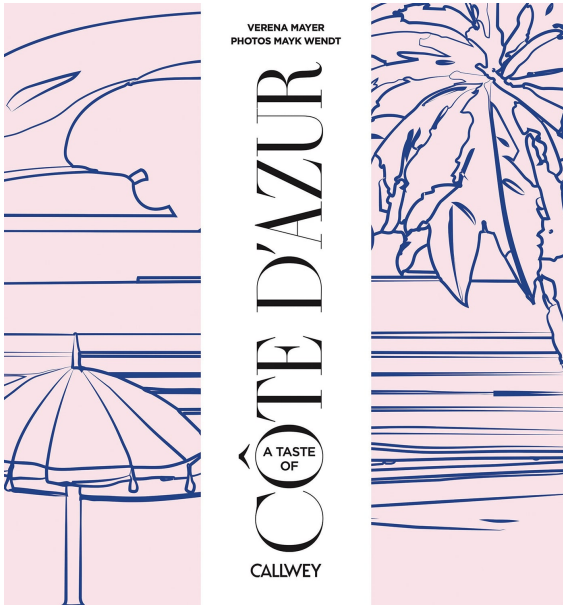




A Taste of Côte D'Azur
