



## Aftermieter/Lodgers

**Haus Modrath**

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- This is the catalogue for the inaugural exhibition curated by Veit Loers, on display until November 2018
- The exhibition, developed by subtenant artists, or 'Aftermieter' as they are called in German, extends across the building's four floors, taking up a total area of 1000 square metres
- With works by: Ed Atkins, Günther Förg, Eva Kot'átková, Andreas Slominski, Franz West, Thomas Zipp u.a./and others.

In an area previously levelled to make way for an opencast mine, Haus Mödrath is a 19th century villa opened in April 2017 as a centre for contemporary art. The classicist mansion and the surrounding park are both part of a project that aims to unite nature and culture.

The inaugural exhibition curated by Veit Loers extends across the building's four floors, boasting a total area of 1000 square metres. It will be on display until November 2018. Instead of putting on a static group exhibition, the curator invited a number of contemporary artists to move in as temporary subtenants, or 'Aftermieter' as they used to be called in German. While the usual furnishings have been removed, the pictures and objects that can be found both inside and outside are arranged in a way that offers surprising perspectives on the contemporary art scene.
