

By utilising abstraction, she creates moments by means of rules and omissions, acceptance and refusal, providing a space for contemplation. Her works do not reference any particular form, and interpretation becomes multifaceted. She has exhibited nationwide, and has been featured in *Architectural Digest, My Domain*, and *Electrify Magazine*. Holly's work can be found in public and private collections worldwide.
