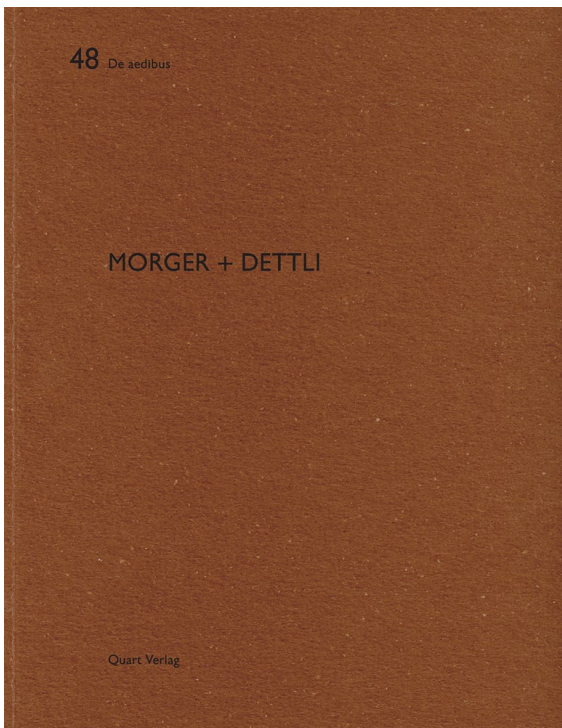




# Morger + Dettli
