A world-class nature photographer, **Yuan Minghui** is the winner of multiple prestigious awards, including the German International Glanzlichter, the UK IGPOY, and the US-hosted NBPA. He is the only Chinese photographer to have won the internationally-acclaimed WPY – the Oscars of nature photography (in 2014, 2019 and 2021), with Italian magazine *Asferico* describing him as the first Chinese nature photographer to be recognised worldwide. He published *The Microcosmos: A Fairytale of Close-up Photography* in 2017.
