Few cities have as rich a collection of modern buildings as São Paulo. Oscar Niemeyer, Vilanova Artigas, Lina Bo Bardi, Rino Levi, and Paulo Mendes da Rocha are some of the best-known names who built here. These architects, alongside many others, contributed decisively to making São Paulo a city with a unique architectural heritage and a legacy worthy of appreciation and dissemination. This guide presents 124 works built between 1925 and 2018, grouped into 12 routes laid out on sectoral maps of São Paulo, allowing readers to explore a broader area of the city and gain a deeper understanding of its scale, diversity, and complexity.
