

He is Alumni Distinguished Professor Emeritus at Virginia Tech, where he formerly served as Executive Director of the Virginia Center for Civil War Studies. He is the author or editor of more than twenty books, including such award-winning studies as *Civil War! America Becomes One Nation, General A.P. Hill,* and *Soldiers Blue and Gray.* His biography of General "Stonewall" Jackson won eight national awards and was used as the basis for the 2003 film *Gods and Generals*, for which he served as a consultant.
