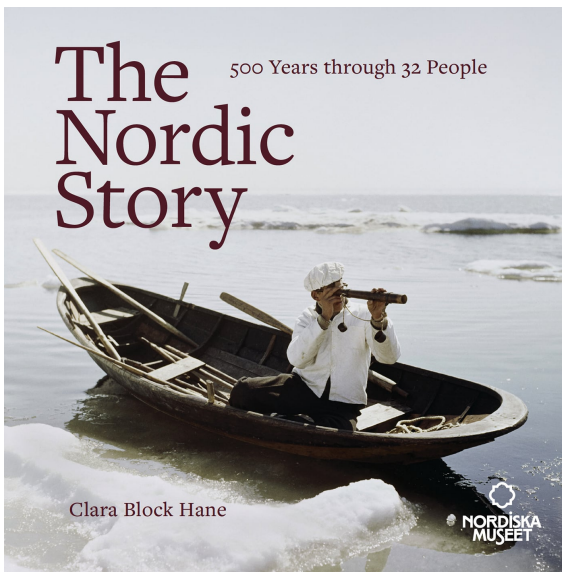

It is based on diaries, letters and other personal testimony, illustrated with objects from Nordiska museet's astonishing collection.
