It offers many previously unpublished images, from Jacques Brel, Martin Luther King, John Lennon, Charles Aznavour, Elizabeth Taylor and Dutch celebrities like Johan Cruyff, princess Beatrix and prince Bernhard to Willeke Alberti. *Starring Amsterdam* is a unique photographic document from Amsterdam at a time when the city is alive and buzzing like never before.
