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• Contemporary design projects of Chinese museum and galleries

Architecture China is a journal focusing on the leading architectural design projects with regional characteristic in contemporary China. This 2022 Fall issue of Architecture China, focusing on how a new culture could be constructed through the action of building, showcases 12 newly completed museums or galleries, all of which express certain characters in contemporary Chinese culture.
