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David Adjaye's second monograph with a+u displays the global expansion of his practice. *a+u 18:02* features international projects such as the Latvian Museum of Contemporary Art, Aishti Foundation, and Moscow School of Management. His ingenious use of materials and sculptural ability have established him as an architect with an artist's sensibility and vision.
