W. Barksdale Maynard is the author of eight books, including *Artists of Wyeth Country: Howard Pyle, N.C. Wyeth, and Andrew Wyeth* (2021). His publications on architecture include *Buildings of Delaware* in the *Buildings of the United States* series, *Architecture in the United States, 1800–1850*, and *Princeton: America's Campus*. He has taught the history of art and architecture at Johns Hopkins University, Princeton University, and elsewhere.
