Stephen Fox is an architectural historian and a Fellow of the Anchorage Foundation of Texas. He is a lecturer in architecture at Rice University and the University of Houston. Fox is the author of *The Architecture of Birdsall P. Briscoe* (2022), the *AIA Houston Architectural Guide* (2012), and *The Country Houses of John F. Staub* (2007). He received an Arthur Ross Award from the Institute of Classical Architecture & Art and a John F. Staub Award from the ICAA's Texas Chapter in 2011.
