Mosaic, the sixth and final volume in Sean Palfrey's photography series, is filled with some of the author's favorite images—an Indonesian fishing boat at rest on a sandy beach in the glow of dusk, a tangle of leaves that look, for a second, like the bared teeth of a fearsome beast, a bright and joyful children's mural, replete with birds and rainbows, and the grey-blue and apricot tints of a canyon wall, scoured by time and weather.

Sean Palfrey has had an illustrious career as a pediatrician, Faculty Dean at Harvard University, and Professor of Clinical Pediatrics and Public Health at Boston University. Simultaneously, Palfrey has spent a lifetime exploring the boundaries of image-making through photography, with his work as a doctor informing his practice. In addition to being a teacher, dean, and clinician, he served as president of the Massachusetts Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics, and he has been a legislative advocate for child health programs and policies since the 1970s. Palfrey exhibits his photography in solo and group shows frequently in the USA.
