The catalogue narrates this widely varied exhibition with contributions by recognized international art critics. Comprehensive data sheets provide detailed descriptions of the works by each artist on show. Extensive iconographic material, including images from archives and photos of the works on show, each in their respective location, will complete the narrative of this important event.

**Sergio Risaliti** is an art historian, creator and curator of exhibitions and important events, writer and journalist. He has founded and directed public and private exhibition centres. He has been working with Francesco Vossilla since 2007 on an unconventional investigation of Michelangelo's work followed by the publication of volumes. He curated, with Cristina Acidini (creator) and Elena Capretti, the exhibition 'Michelangelo Buonarroti. Incontrare un artista universale', at Musei Capitolini in Rome, and together with Francesca Campana Comparini the exhibition 'Jackson Pollock, La figura della furia', in Palazzo Vecchio in Florence. He created and curated, with Arabella Natalini, the solo shows of Giuseppe Penone. 'Prospettiva Vegetale', in 2014, and in 2015 Antony Gormley 'Human at Forte' Belvedere in Florence. Since 2017 he has been the Director of Museo Novecento in Florence.
